**EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 04-22**

**AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF  
VALLEJO ORDERING PURCHASE OF COVID-19 TESTS FROM AVALLINO LABS**

WHEREAS, COVID-19, caused by the novel Coronavirus, has spread throughout the United States and frequently causes severe illness and death; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared a national emergency as a result of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California has declared a state emergency as a result of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the County of Solano has declared a county-wide emergency as a result of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vallejo has declared a City-wide emergency as a result of the Coronavirus on March 16, 2020 by Resolution No.20-026; and

WHEREAS, residents of the state and of the City of Vallejo ("City") have been dramatically impacted by COVID-19 and federal, state and local government responses thereto; and

WHEREAS, businesses in the state and in the City of Vallejo have lost business income as well as employees as a result of COVID-19 and federal, state and local government responses thereto; and

WHEREAS, the state of California and the County of Solano have issued stay-at-home orders dramatically limiting the movement of people in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the majority of other states have also issued stay-at-home orders essentially ending all tourism in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, this Emergency Order is based upon evidence of increasing need for testing; and

WHEREAS, the tests will be utilized for City of Vallejo public safety employees and front line employees, as needed, as well as contribute to testing of vulnerable populations such as the homeless and residents of long-term care facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.50.070(D)(1) of the City of Vallejo Municipal Code empowers the Director of Emergency Services to make and issue rules and regulations on matters reasonably related to the protection of life and property as affected by any emergency proclaimed by the Director of Emergency Services or by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. It is found by the Director of Emergency Services that due to the novel coronavirus, the City will purchase 3,334 COVID-19 tests from Avallino Labs of Menlo Park.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERD that this order shall remain in full force and effect until the City Council determines that the Emergency proclaimed by the City on March 16, 2020 is over


IT IS FURTHER ORDERD that this order shall be presented to the City Council for ratification at the earliest possible time.
