SACRAMENTO STREET BRIDGE

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Sacramento Street Bridge over Mare Island Railroad (Bridge) is located between Illinois Street and Farragut Ave on Sacramento Street. The Bridge was identified to have seismic vulnerabilities relative to current standards and the City received a funding grant for replacement of bridge. Funding sources for the project include 88.5% federal funds from the Highway Bridge Program and 11.5% local matching funds. Modifications to the existing roadway approaches required to meet the new bridge configurations will also be built. A construction contract was awarded by City Council on 2-22-21 and the City is currently starting the Construction Phase of the Project.

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FARRAGUT AVE CLOSURE


Farragut Ave will be closed to thru traffic to allow for utility work needed before the Bridge can be replaced. Access to residences will be maintained during this work. Detour routes during this closure will be clearly identified by local signage.

April 5, 2021



SACRAMENTO STREET CLOSURE

Sacramento Street will be closed to vehicle-traffic to allow for demolition of the old bridge and construction of the new bridge and roadway approaches. Pedestrian access over the railway and to residences will be maintained during this work. Detour routes during this closure will be clearly identified by local signage.
