2 College Counselors & 30 4-year scholarships Goal: Serve all Vallejo students. Double number of Vallejo students going to college.



Cost \$320,000 **Location** Vallejo High Schools

Who Benefits

- 1. All Vallejo students provided college counseling 9th-12th grades. College mentoring, aid with FAFSA, SAT, etc.
- 2. Community with college educated leaders and community service.
- 3. Students receiving scholarships.

Project Description

College Bound Vallejo expands the work of college access programs: Willie B Adkins, Vallejo Hope, and 10000 Degrees. College advisers will counsel and help students with all aspects of college eligibility and readiness, FAFSA, SAT and college applications.

Scholarships for 30 students will be given to those with most need who are low-income or first-generation college students. The scholarship will provide \$2000/year over 4 years.

Each recipient will agree to 300 hours of community service in Vallejo.

The investment would be administered through the Willie B Adkins Project and the Vallejo Hope Scholarship Fund/10000 Degrees partnership. All are non-profit scholarship funds.
