
D2 150 Camera Pilot with Intelligent Archives

One year Pilot evaluates use of intelligent archives to watch cameras & license plates by detectives, prosecutors, and police.

Project Description

The Camera Pilot includes 150 internet protocol (IP) cameras, 4 pan/tilt/zoom (PTZ) IP cameras, 5 fixed license plate readers (LPR), 15 intelligent archive servers, an IP network, and integrating software with a web interface. All cameras will be located in public areas where there is no expectation of privacy.

The intelligent archives monitor the cameras and detect events in real time. Events from fixed IP cameras aim the PTZ cameras. Camera and LPR events are integrated for display on a dynamic map.

The Pilot evaluation report will address scalability and the ability to integrate evolving technology. Pilot metrics will evaluate its effectiveness in support of police actions, detective research, and prosecutor needs.
