## APPROVING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET FOR FY 2018-2019 AND APPROVING THE FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FY 2018-2019 THROUGH FY2022-2023

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission reviewed the FY 2018-2019 through FY 2022-2023 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and found that it conforms to the City's General Plan on June 4, 2018.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council was provided the Planning Commission's recommendations from the June 4, 2018 Planning Commission meeting, along with the associated staff report.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agrees with the recommendations regarding General Plan consistency as contained in the Planning Commission resolution and the staff report, adopts the same by reference, and finds the 5 Year CIP to be consistent with the City's General Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vallejo that:

- 1. The FY 2018-19 Capital Improvement Program Budget is approved; and
- 2. The FY 2018-2019 through FY2022-2023 5 year Capital Improvement Program is consistent with the General Plan.
- 3. The FY 2018-2019 through FY 2022-2023 5 year Capital Improvement Program is hereby approved.
- 4. Funds, in the amount of \$15,476,604 are appropriated for the FY 2018-2019 CIP budget; and
- 5. The previous appropriations for Capital Projects in FY2017-2018 are adjusted, carried over and re-appropriated into 2018-2019.
- 6. The previous appropriations for Participatory Budgeting projects, that are unexpended in 2017-2018 are carried over and re-appropriated into 2018-2019 and may be administered, tracked and shown within the CIP Program.
