Detailed Project Description:

Vallejo has rising pet dog, pet cat and stray/feral cat and dog populations. The Humane Society of the North Bay implements a successful pet dog and pet cat affordable spay and neuter program which has helped stem uncontrolled domesticated animal populations. Funding is requested for continued success and in addition to start a Trap, Neuter and Return program for feral cats. TNR displaces the fertile members of feral cat colonies with neutered cats. This stops the population growth, while the cats become less damaging and aggressive. Funding is required for the surgeries of the pet dogs, pet cats and feral cats and the production of instructional literature. The Humane Society takes no Participatory Budgeting money for itself.
