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MARE ISLAND WESTERN APPROACH REPLACEMENT BRIDGE PROJECT UPDATE

The Mare Island Western Approach replacement project began on July 6, 2015. This project will replace a 50-foot section of original timber-trestle and is being executed in two stages in order to maintain one-way traffic coming on to Mare Island.

Demolition on the eastern portion of the approach, which includes the pedestrian path and outbound traffic lanes, was demolished the week of July 27. The pedestrian and bicycle path now crosses the railroad bridge and will continue onto G Street when complete.



Construction crews will begin installing stabilizing piles that range from 80-100 feet long in mid-August. The Causeway will be completely closed to traffic in late August for three to five days from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. in order for construction crews to complete piling operations. At least one week advance notice will be provided through traffic signs and the City's <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Nextdoor</u> accounts. Regular construction updates continue to be published through the City Manager's <u>Bi-Weekly Report</u>.
